

LA10T – Acceptable Use Policy (AUP)

This Acceptable Use Policy (“AUP”) governs the access to and use of the LA10T platform (“LA10T”, pronounced “Latent”), including its website, mobile applications, dashboards, AssetStore, Marketplace, Community Drive programmes, Social Community features and related services (collectively, the “Platform”).

This AUP applies to all Users, Affiliated Partners, ambassadors, enterprise clients, programme sponsors and any individual or entity accessing or interacting with the Platform.

By accessing or using the Platform, you agree to comply with this AUP, which forms part of and is incorporated into the LA10T Terms & Conditions.

1. Lawful Use

You may access and use the Platform only for lawful purposes and in compliance with all applicable laws, regulations and industry standards. You must not use the Platform to:

- Violate any applicable law, regulation or governmental order
- Infringe intellectual property, privacy, publicity or other proprietary rights
- Engage in fraudulent, deceptive, misleading or unfair practices
- Facilitate unlawful, prohibited or restricted transactions
- Circumvent sanctions, export controls or trade restrictions
- Engage in bribery, corruption or improper influence in connection with programme participation
- Make false or exaggerated environmental, sustainability or impact-related claims

Users are solely responsible for ensuring that their use of the Platform complies with applicable legal and regulatory obligations in their jurisdiction.

2. Participation Integrity

The integrity of participation data and impact recognition is fundamental to the Platform. You must not:

- Submit false, fabricated or misleading participation records
- Artificially inflate scan activity or transaction confirmations
- Use automated tools, bots, scripts or other mechanisms to generate artificial activity
- Create duplicate or coordinated accounts to obtain additional EcoCoin
- Collude with other users to fabricate AssetStore transfers or Marketplace purchases
- Manipulate or attempt to manipulate Monitoring, Reporting and Verification (MRV) processes
- Misrepresent role attribution (including giver or receiver designation)
- Circumvent system boundaries, validation logic or anti-duplication controls
- Exploit technical vulnerabilities for impact recognition or EcoCoin issuance

LA10T reserves the right to:

- Withhold, revoke, adjust or reverse impact recognition
- Reclaim issued EcoCoin
- Suspend or terminate accounts
- Restrict access to specific modules
- Investigate and take appropriate legal action

Enforcement actions may apply retroactively where manipulation or fraud is identified.

3. AssetStore Conduct

Users participating in the AssetStore module must comply with applicable laws and conduct transactions in good faith. You must not:

- List prohibited, illegal, restricted, hazardous or regulated items
- List counterfeit, stolen or unauthorised goods
- Misrepresent the condition, authenticity, ownership or legality of items
- Engage in fraudulent, fabricated or coordinated transfer confirmations
- Circumvent payment holding, escrow or transaction confirmation mechanisms
- Attempt to complete transactions outside the Platform to avoid verification controls
- Harass, threaten, coerce or exploit other users
- Manipulate reuse attribution to generate artificial impact recognition

Users are solely responsible for:

- Ensuring lawful ownership and transfer rights
- Complying with applicable consumer protection and safety laws
- Verifying the suitability and safety of items received

LA10T:

- Does not take ownership of listed items
- Does not inspect, guarantee or certify the condition or legality of items
- Is not responsible for delivery failures, defects or disputes between users

LA10T reserves the right to remove listings, suspend transactions, withhold impact recognition or restrict access where violations are suspected.

4. Marketplace Conduct

Affiliated Partners and users participating in the Marketplace must ensure that all product information, sustainability representations and related data are accurate, substantiated and lawful. You must not:

- Make false, misleading, exaggerated or unsubstantiated sustainability or environmental claims
- Misrepresent product specifications, origin, materials or lifecycle attributes
- Submit inaccurate, incomplete or manipulated data for baseline comparison purposes
- Use Platform participation recognition to imply regulatory approval, certification, carbon credit issuance, or independent ESG verification
- Advertise EcoCoin or Platform outputs as compliance instruments or regulated offsets
- Engage in deceptive marketing practices or greenwashing

Affiliated Partners are responsible for ensuring that all product claims comply with applicable consumer protection, advertising and environmental marketing laws. LA10T reserves the right to:

- Suspend or remove Marketplace listings
- Withhold or adjust impact recognition
- Restrict or terminate Affiliated Partner access
- Require correction or clarification of misleading claims
- Take appropriate legal action where necessary

Enforcement actions may apply retroactively where misrepresentation is discovered.

5. Social Community Conduct

Users engaging with Social Community features must act responsibly and lawfully. You must not post, upload, transmit or share content that:

- Is defamatory, abusive, threatening, hateful, discriminatory or harassing
- Infringes intellectual property, privacy or publicity rights
- Contains unlawful, harmful or unsafe material
- Promotes scams, fraudulent schemes or deceptive practices
- Contains false, exaggerated or misleading sustainability or environmental claims
- Misrepresents Platform outputs as certified, regulated or independently verified
- Discloses confidential or proprietary information without authorisation
- Contains malware, malicious code or harmful links

Users remain solely responsible for the content they submit. LA10T may, at its sole discretion:

- Review, moderate, restrict or remove content
- Suspend or terminate accounts
- Preserve moderation records for compliance purposes
- Report unlawful conduct to appropriate authorities

LA10T does not endorse user-generated content and does not assume responsibility for opinions expressed by users.

6. EcoCoin and Recognition Integrity

EcoCoin is a participation-based, utility recognition mechanism within the Platform and is not designed or intended to function as a financial, investment or regulated instrument. Users must not:

- Represent EcoCoin as a financial asset, security, investment or store of value
- Market or describe EcoCoin as a regulated carbon credit, compliance offset or tradable environmental instrument
- Sell, transfer, trade or promote EcoCoin outside authorised Platform mechanisms
- Use EcoCoin for speculative, exchange or fundraising purposes
- Create secondary markets or exchange arrangements without express written authorisation
- Attempt to reverse engineer, interfere with or exploit ledger or traceability systems
- Circumvent issuance, retirement or validation controls

EcoCoin:

- Does not represent ownership rights
- Does not confer equity, dividend, voting or redemption rights
- Does not guarantee monetary value
- Does not constitute legal tender

LA10T reserves the right to:

- Withhold, revoke, adjust or retire EcoCoin
- Restrict access to EcoCoin-related features
- Investigate misuse or misrepresentation
- Take appropriate legal or enforcement action

7. Security and Platform Protection

You must not engage in any activity that compromises the security, integrity or availability of the Platform. You must not:

- Attempt to access unauthorised areas of the Platform, systems, databases or networks
- Reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble, copy or otherwise attempt to derive source code, algorithms or proprietary methodologies
- Interfere with, disrupt or degrade system architecture, servers, or infrastructure
- Introduce viruses, malware, malicious code or harmful scripts
- Exploit technical vulnerabilities or attempt unauthorised penetration testing
- Circumvent authentication, rate limits or security controls
- Use automated scraping, bots or data harvesting tools without authorisation
- Share account credentials or permit unauthorised third-party access

Any security testing, vulnerability reporting or research must be conducted only with prior written authorisation from LA10T. LA10T reserves the right to:

- Suspend or terminate accounts
- Restrict access to affected modules
- Investigate suspected security breaches
- Pursue legal remedies where appropriate

8. Government and Programme Deployments

Where the Platform is deployed in connection with enterprise, institutional or government-led programmes, all participants must act with integrity and in compliance with applicable laws and programme rules. Users, Affiliated Partners and programme sponsors must not:

- Manipulate participation metrics or artificially inflate engagement statistics
- Submit fabricated, falsified or misleading participation records
- Coordinate collusive activity to influence programme outcomes
- Misuse aggregated reports, dashboards or impact summaries for deceptive public communication
- Represent Platform-generated outputs as certified regulatory compliance results

- Use participation recognition to mislead investors, regulators or public authorities

Enterprise clients and programme sponsors are responsible for ensuring that any public disclosure of programme metrics accurately reflects the Platform's participation-based methodology. LA10T reserves the right to:

- Conduct integrity reviews of programme data
- Adjust or revoke impact recognition where manipulation is detected
- Restrict access to affected accounts or modules
- Terminate programme participation
- Cooperate with relevant authorities where required by law

9. Enforcement

LA10T may take appropriate action where it reasonably believes that a user, Affiliated Partner, ambassador, enterprise client or programme participant has violated this AUP, the Terms & Conditions or applicable law. Enforcement actions may include, without limitation:

- Suspension or termination of accounts
- Removal or restriction of content, listings or participation records
- Withholding, adjustment, revocation or retirement of EcoCoin
- Restriction of access to specific modules or features
- Temporary transaction holds or investigation measures
- Referral to law enforcement or regulatory authorities where required
- Initiation of civil or other legal proceedings

LA10T may take enforcement action with or without prior notice where necessary to:

- Protect platform integrity
- Prevent fraud or manipulation
- Maintain security
- Comply with legal or regulatory obligations

Enforcement decisions are made at LA10T's discretion and may apply retroactively where misconduct is discovered.

10. Updates to This AUP

LA10T may update or modify this Acceptable Use Policy from time to time to reflect changes in:

- Platform features or functionality
- Legal or regulatory requirements
- Security standards
- Enforcement practices

Updated versions of this AUP will be published on the Platform with a revised "Last Updated" date.

Where changes are material, LA10T may provide additional notice through the Platform or other appropriate communication channels.

Your continued access to or use of the Platform after the effective date of the updated AUP constitutes acceptance of the revised policy.

If you do not agree to the updated AUP, you must discontinue use of the Platform.
