

LA10T – Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy explains how LA10T (“LA10T”, pronounced “Latent”), uses cookies and similar tracking technologies when you access or use the LA10T platform, including its website, mobile applications, dashboards, AssetStore, Marketplace, Community Drive programmes, Social Community features and related services (collectively, the “Platform”).

This Cookie Policy forms part of and should be read together with the LA10T Privacy Policy, which describes how Personal Data is collected, used, processed and protected.

1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you access a website or digital service. They allow the service to recognise your device, maintain session state, enhance security and improve user experience.

In addition to browser-based cookies, LA10T may use similar technologies in web and mobile environments, including:

- Local storage mechanisms
- Software Development Kits (SDKs) within mobile applications
- Pixel tags or web beacons
- Device identifiers (such as device ID or application instance ID)
- Advertising identifiers, where permitted by device settings and applicable law

These technologies may collect information about device type, session activity, usage patterns and interaction events to support functionality, analytics and platform integrity.

2. Types of Cookies We Use

2.1 Strictly Necessary (Functional) Cookies

Strictly necessary cookies are essential for the secure and proper operation of the Platform. These cookies do not require consent where permitted by applicable law, as they are required to deliver core services requested by the user. These cookies enable:

- User authentication and secure login sessions
- Account protection and credential validation
- Fraud detection and prevention controls
- Monitoring, Reporting, and Verification (MRV) integrity safeguards
- Prevention of duplicate or automated activity
- System security and anomaly detection
- Load balancing and performance stabilisation

Without these cookies or equivalent technical mechanisms, certain features of the Platform may not function properly and security controls may be impaired.

2.2 Performance and Analytics Cookies

Performance and analytics cookies help LA10T understand how users interact with the Platform and evaluate system performance. These technologies may collect information such as:

- Page visits and navigation patterns
- Feature usage metrics
- Scan activity trends (in aggregated form)
- Error reports and diagnostic information
- Session duration and engagement statistics

Analytics data is used to generate aggregated insights and may be anonymised or de-identified where reasonably practicable. Analytics tools help improve:

- Platform performance and stability
- Feature usability and interface design
- Monitoring, Reporting and Verification (MRV) efficiency
- System reliability and user experience optimisation

Where required by applicable law, non-essential analytics cookies will be deployed only with user consent. You may manage analytics preferences through browser settings or available consent mechanisms.

2.3 Security and Integrity Cookies

LA10T may use cookies and similar technical mechanisms to safeguard the security, integrity, and reliability of the Platform. These mechanisms may be used to:

- Detect suspicious or anomalous activity
- Prevent duplicate or coordinated account creation
- Identify automated, scripted, or bot-driven behaviour
- Enforce rate limits and access controls
- Protect Monitoring, Reporting, and Verification (MRV) processes
- Maintain EcoCoin issuance validation integrity

Security and integrity mechanisms are essential to prevent fraud, manipulation, and artificial inflation of participation activity.

Such technologies are deployed for platform protection purposes and may operate without separate consent where permitted by applicable law.

2.4 Preference Cookies

Preference cookies allow the Platform to remember certain choices you make to enhance your experience. These cookies may store information such as:

- Language preferences
- Display or interface settings
- Notification preferences
- Cookie consent selections

Preference cookies improve usability and personalisation but are not strictly necessary for core Platform functionality.

Where required by applicable law, preference cookies will be deployed only after obtaining user consent. You may modify your preferences through available settings or browser controls.

2.5 Mobile Application Technologies

When you access the Platform through a mobile application, LA10T may use embedded technologies to support functionality, security and performance. These may include:

- Software Development Kits (SDKs)
- Device identifiers (such as application instance ID or device ID)
- Diagnostic tracking tools
- Crash analytics and performance monitoring tools

These technologies may collect limited technical and usage information to support:

- Application stability and reliability
- Performance monitoring and optimisation
- Security enforcement and fraud detection
- Error diagnostics and troubleshooting

Where required by applicable law or device settings, certain identifiers (including advertising identifiers) will be used only with user consent.

LA10T does not use mobile tracking technologies for unauthorised profiling or behavioural advertising.

3. Location-Related Data

Where enabled by your device settings or required for specific Platform features, LA10T may collect limited location-related information. This may include:

- Country-level location derived from IP address

- Approximate geographic region (such as city or state)
- Location metadata associated with scan events, AssetStore transfers or Marketplace transaction validation

Location-related data may be used for:

- Monitoring, Reporting and Verification (MRV) validation
- Fraud detection and prevention
- Prevention of duplicate participation activity
- Regional baseline modelling and impact allocation
- Community Drive programme analytics

LA10T does not conduct continuous real-time location tracking. Precise GPS location data will only be collected where:

- Explicitly enabled through device permissions; and
- Permitted by applicable law.

Users may manage location permissions through device settings.

4. Third-Party Cookies and Technologies

LA10T may engage trusted third-party service providers to support the operation and performance of the Platform. These providers may include:

- Cloud hosting infrastructure providers
- Analytics and performance monitoring services
- Security monitoring providers
- Payment processing partners
- Mobile SDK providers
- Any other service providers

Such providers may deploy cookies or similar tracking technologies within the Platform to deliver contracted services.

These third parties are contractually required to process data only in accordance with applicable data protection laws and agreed service terms.

LA10T does not control the independent privacy practices of third-party providers. Users are encouraged to review the privacy policies of relevant providers before engaging with external services.

Inclusion of third-party technologies does not constitute endorsement of their products or services.

5. How Long Cookies Are Stored

Cookies and similar tracking technologies may be stored for varying durations depending on their purpose and function. Cookies may be:

- **Session cookies**, which are automatically deleted when you close your browser or application session; or
- **Persistent cookies**, which remain on your device for a defined period or until manually deleted.

The retention period for cookies depends on:

- The purpose for which the cookie is used
- Security and fraud prevention requirements
- Platform integrity and performance needs
- Legal or regulatory obligations

Security-related and integrity-related cookies may be retained for longer periods where necessary to detect abuse, prevent duplicate participation activity or protect Monitoring, Reporting and Verification (MRV) processes.

LA10T applies reasonable measures to ensure that cookies are not retained longer than necessary for their intended purpose.

6. Managing Cookie Preferences

You may manage or restrict the use of cookies and similar tracking technologies through:

- Your web browser settings
- Device-level privacy or advertising controls
- Platform-provided cookie consent tools (where applicable)

Most browsers allow you to:

- View stored cookies
- Delete existing cookies
- Block future cookies
- Configure alerts before cookies are placed

On mobile devices, you may adjust:

- Advertising identifier settings
- Tracking permissions
- Location permissions
- Application-level privacy controls

Where non-essential cookies are deployed based on consent, you may withdraw or modify your consent at any time through available settings.

Please note that disabling certain cookies or tracking mechanisms may:

- Affect authentication and secure login
- Limit feature availability
- Impair fraud prevention mechanisms
- Impact Monitoring, Reporting, and Verification (MRV) safeguards
- Reduce overall Platform functionality

7. Legal Basis

Where required by applicable data protection laws, LA10T relies on one or more of the following legal bases for the use of cookies and similar tracking technologies:

- **Legitimate Interests**, for strictly necessary and security-related cookies that are essential for authentication, fraud prevention, system integrity and Monitoring, Reporting and Verification (MRV) safeguards
- **Contractual Necessity**, where cookies are required to deliver Platform features requested by the user
- **Consent**, for non-essential cookies, including certain analytics or preference cookies, where consent is required under applicable law.

In jurisdictions where consent is required prior to the deployment of non-essential cookies, LA10T will obtain such consent through appropriate mechanisms.

You may withdraw consent for non-essential cookies at any time through available preference settings, without affecting the lawfulness of processing conducted prior to withdrawal.

8. Updates to This Cookie Policy

LA10T may update or modify this Cookie Policy from time to time to reflect changes in:

- Platform functionality
- Tracking technologies
- Legal or regulatory requirements
- Security or operational practices

Updated versions of this Cookie Policy will be published on the Platform with a revised “Last Updated” date.

Where changes are material, LA10T may provide additional notice through the Platform or other appropriate communication channels.

Your continued access to or use of the Platform after the effective date of the updated Cookie Policy constitutes acknowledgement of the revised policy.

If you do not agree with the updated terms, you should discontinue use of the Platform or adjust your cookie preferences accordingly.

9. Contact

For enquiries relating to this Cookie Policy, including questions about tracking technologies or consent preferences, you may contact LA10T through the official support channels published on the Platform.

Where required for formal legal or regulatory purposes, written communications may be submitted to the contact details designated on the Platform or to such updated address as LA10T may specify from time to time.

LA10T will use reasonable efforts to respond to cookie-related enquiries within a commercially reasonable timeframe.
